
Bingo Success

Neighbors Helping Neighbors Stay Safe

Operating under the umbrella of CCT, the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT Team) is a dedicated group of highly motivated residents from SGC who have volunteered to take the required training for the purpose of forming and developing our local group. The heart of the CERT program is "A Neighbor Helping Neighbor."

How are we funded?

CERT is self-funded. There are no tax dollars provided by the County. The County only provides training for volunteers. Funding is needed to maintain the trailer, stock all the necessary supplies and provide go bags for our volunteers.

What does this mean for you?

In case of a major disastrous event, County provided emergency services could be negatively impacted and communication may be impinged. As soon as possible and when safe to do so, CERT assessment patrols start a visual survey of our community to determine damage levels and provide aid to those who require it. If our community experiences a significant destructive incident, the CERT team would provide a first response benefit to all SGC residents.

CCT Programs 10

The CCT CARE Committee is growing and doing great things for our community

The Care Committee is a program under the Conservancy and Community Trust of SGC, the community 501c3 non-profit, The all volunteer committee was formed in 2013 to provide a means for our neighbors to support projects and volunteer programs through donations of food, clothing, monetary sums, and other items as requested. The Care Committee placed donation bins and baskets at the clubhouse for donations. Bins include a hamper for gently used children's clothing for Kids Needs of Englewood, a wooden house box for drink pull tabs for the Ronald McDonald House, a box for eyeglasses for the Lion's Club, and a basket for hotel size toiletries for the Jesus Loves You mobile shower for the homeless. Information on projects or collections can be obtained through monthly newsletters, clubhouse bulletin boards, the CCT Facebook page, or contacting a Care Committee member. Our two signature projects occur in late summer and early fall.

- August is back to school supplies and Backpacks for Kids' Needs-these items go directly to students enrolled in local schools or in need of supplies.
- Santa Sack prep begins in August following the Back to School collections

 December we assemble our Santa Sacks for Englewood Meal on Wheels recipients. The sacks include a variety of treats, toiletries, and Christmas gifts. Monies for these projects are collected through donations and fundraising. Our Committee has several local businesses

that we work with for donations.

- The need for side street speed signs Response: The county did a speed study within SGC, if there is NO posted street speed limit they are considered to be 30 mph
- Additional sidewalks within SGC Response: Original plan is to have sidewalks on the 4 main roads, San Domingo, Ingraham, Keystone,and Appleton, in addition to Hallandale, Calumet and St Paul. Final Phase almost complete on San Domingo







The **Neighborhood Watch Program** started over 25 years ago and has been around since the neighborhood's early development phase when SGC had less than 100 houses. Over the years, SGC has evolved to a community that presently has over 4,000 + houses.

The program is designed to assist Charlotte County Sheriff's Office with extra eyes on our beautiful community.

Its primary purpose is to ensure our community is safe from attempted burglaries and vandalism, eliminate vagrants from setting up tent sites, and waylay vacant lots from becoming party sites with bonfires.

The Neighborhood Watch Program does not eliminate the need for home security systems.

The Neighborhood Watch Program is made up of Primary, Substitute, and Roaming Volunteers. The volunteers are the BACKBONE of the program. Without the volunteers there would NOT be a Neighborhood Watch Program. Each volunteer is issued a magnetic sign to put on their car door and the Charlotte County Sheriff's office provides vests which identify them as a Neighborhood Watch Volunteer.

Monthly meetings are held at the SGC Clubhouse on the second Thursday of each month with the Charlotte County Sheriff's Office and anyone interested in the program is welcome to attend.





"Slow Speed, Minimum Wake Zone"

Areas where vessels must be fully off plane and completely settled in the water. Any wake created by a vessel in one of these zones must be minimal (very small) If your vessel is traveling with the bow even slightly elevated while in one of these zones, it is not proceeding at "Slow speed" as required by law.

Updates from the SGC MSBU Advisory Boards

What is the MSBU?

Municipal Service Benefit Units are taxing units within specific defined communities of Charlotte County

The Purpose of the Waterway MSBU:

SGC Waterway MSBU (Taxes collected) is to provide for: (1) periodic dredging, (2) any repair, expansion or replacement of the waterways, canals, locks or accessory facilities, (3) operation of the lock, and (4) the removal of cattails from the Interceptor Lagoon waterway. Currently each wet lot in SGC and Holiday Lakes pays \$50 annually to the MSBU, Dry lots in SGC pay \$25.

The Purpose of the Streets and Drainage MSBU:

S&D MSBU (Taxes collected) is to provide for road maintenance, repaving, sidewalk & bike paths, right of way lawn cutting, bridge maintenance and more.

The advisory board is made up of community residents appointed by the Charlotte County Commission. The board meets quarterly and all meetings are open to the public. The community is encouraged to attend and give feedback.

The next Waterway MSBU meeting will be held on Wednesday March 22nd 9:30am.

The next S & D MSBU meeting will be held on April 13th at the West County Annex 6868 San Casa Dr. Room 120 Engelwood FL The Public is encouraged to attend all MSBU meeting.

Waterway MSBU updates:


- discussed water quality (water samples are collected at 5 locations quarterly)

- discussed the budget to dredge the canals inside the lock, how to devise a plan that is cost effective and beneficial to the community. community input needed before the March meeting on canals that are shallower than expected.
- discussed the parallel lock project and the recent decision of FFW to not recommend the second lock due to the manatee death
- estimated cost of 12 million for the second lock which the community will bare the expense of As an advisory committee we can make recommendation to the commissioners. Do we want to continue with the parallel lock project given the efficiency of having the lock tender daily 7-7pm? Should we close the lock temporarity and rebuild it to last another 50 years? If a second lock is built, can it be built bigger to accommodate the growing community and remove the existing lock? Should it be removed all together? Email your thoughts to Ms. Kelley at the above email.

S & D MSBU updates:

- San Domingo sidewalks past Calumet should be completed in the spring of 2023.
- Bridge maintenance/construction of adding sidewalks will be delayed on the following 4 bridges. Appleton, Keystone, Ingraham, and Presidents Waterway
- Mangrove trimming has been completed and new flowers were planted in the planter boxes in August
- Phase paving will begin in 2025, Phase 3 in 2027
