Community Emergency Response Team South Gulf Cove Charlotte County, FL. Neighbor Helping Neighbor

Neighbors Helping Neighbors Stay Safe

Operating under the umbrella of CCT, the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT Team) is a dedicated group of highly motivated residents from SGC who have volunteered to take the required training for the purpose of forming and developing our local group. The heart of the CERT program is "A Neighbor Helping Neighbor."

How are we funded?

CERT is self-funded. There are no tax dollars provided by the County. The County only provides training for volunteers. Funding is needed to maintain the trailer, stock all the necessary supplies and provide go bags for our volunteers.

What does this mean for you?

In case of a major disastrous event, County provided emergency services could be negatively impacted and communication may be impinged. As soon as possible and when safe to do so, CERT assessment patrols start a visual survey of our community to determine damage levels and provide aid to those who require it. If our community experiences a significant destructive incident, the CERT team would provide a first response benefit to all SGC residents.

SGC CERT is looking for "Friends of SGC CERT". Someone may be interested in joining but the county training has been postponed for some reason. Residents may have had prior training in emergency response or have additional equipment for use during an emergency. Our SGC CERT team and community will always welcome your help.

New Emergency Communication antenna installed at the SGC Clubhouse by CERT

We learned a lot after Hurricane Ian, especially the importance of having communication in the community when everything is shut down. The CERT team has been hard at work raising funds to implement a communication system in the event SGC is ever faced with another disaster like Hurricane Ian.

CERT's Accomplishments Since March:

- 1st fundraiser since 2019 was held April 1st, Parrot Jack Head party
- July CERT Bingo fundraiser
- CERT purchased 20 GMRS radios for emergency communication
- CERT installed 2 antennas at the SGC HOA Clubhouse for HAM & GMRS radio communication
- CERT holds a monthly HAM radio information net to practice radio communication
- CERT improved our team phone tree activation via phone text for faster response times.



The CCT CARE Committee is growing and doing great things for our community



The Care Committee, a committee under the CCT's umbrella, was established in 2010 as a means for our community to support charitable organizations via a central location through donations of food, clothing, monetary sums or other items as requested.

Throughout 2023 the Care Committee has been hosting fundraisers and activities to support various charitable organizations. These fundraisers, along with neighborhood donations, benefit our signature projects such as Kid's Needs, Englewood Meals on Wheels (EMOW), Jesus Loves you Ministry for the homeless, and allow us to maintain a budget for supporting other charities or families in need.

Care fundraisers and activity in 2023:

- Applebee's Pancake Breakfast fundraiser raised over \$1200
- Virginia B. Andes Volunteer Community Clinic benefitted from a donation of medical supplies and home health care items.
- Jesus Loves you Ministry received monthly deliveries of "hotel size" toiletries for their mobile shower units and hygiene closet.
- SGC residents donated styrofoam coolers, ice packs, and larger donations to the Thrift Store located at 1734 Cedarwood St.
- Lions club-Over 70 pairs of used eyeglasses collected and donated
- Kids Needs Back to School Collection-Bingo hot dog sales yielded \$180, the collection bin at the clubhouse was filled with supplies by the community, and our partnership with XI Theta Service Sorority came through with monetary donations, supples and clothing
- Santa Sacks prep this summer creating 150 shell snowmen ornaments and christmas cards with our 25 volunteers
- Care committee Charity Bingo fundraiser-monies will go towards Santa Sack supplies and Kids' Needs closet
- Oct-Dec-The Care Committee will bring it all together by creating the gift sacks to be delivered with EMOW's Holiday meal delivery.

The **Neighborhood Watch Program** started over 25 years ago and has been around since the neighborhood's early development phase when SGC had less than 100 houses. Over the years, SGC has evolved to a community that presently has over 4,000 + houses.

The program is designed to assist Charlotte County Sheriff's Office with extra eyes on our beautiful community.

Its primary purpose is to ensure our community is safe from attempted burglaries and vandalism, eliminate vagrants from setting up tent sites, and waylay vacant lots from becoming party sites with bonfires.

The Neighborhood Watch Program does not eliminate the need for home security systems.

The Neighborhood Watch Program is made up of Primary, Substitute, and Roaming Volunteers. The volunteers are the BACKBONE of the program. Without the volunteers there would NOT be a Neighborhood Watch Program. Each volunteer is issued a magnetic sign to put on their car door and the Charlotte County Sheriff's office provides vests which identify them as a Neighborhood Watch Volunteer.

Monthly meetings are held at the SGC Clubhouse on the second Thursday of each month with the Charlotte County Sheriff's Office and anyone interested in the program is welcome to attend.

As a community service, Charlotte County Fire & EMS have a smoke detector program in which firefighters will assist residents with:

- Check smoke detectors to identify if the detectors are in working order
- Replace 9-volt batteries in existing, in date, working smoke detectors
- Assist residents with the installation of a nonelectric, ten-year battery operated detectors, provided by the resident
- Educate residents on the proper care of smoke detectors and provide fire safety and fire extinguisher information.

As a reminder ALL canals in South Gulf Cove are Minimum Wake



"Slow Speed, Minimum Wake Zone" Areas where vessels must be fully off plane and completely settled in the water. Any wake created by a vessel in one of these zones must be minimal (very small) If your vessel is traveling with the bow even slightly elevated while in one of these zones, it is not proceeding at "Slow speed" as required by law.

South Gulf Cove Waterway MSBU update

We would like to provide two updates from the recent MSBU meeting held on September 13, 2023

The first is in reference to the map to the right of the waterway exit to and from the lock and into Charlotte Harbor. As you may know, we recently dredged this waterway to ensure sufficient depth and width when exiting or entering our community. Hurricane Ian has impacted that waterway, and we must now exercise caution when traversing this channel. The map show there is sufficient depth for vessels: however, some areas are narrower than expected. We are evaluationg the next steps and how quickly this can be dredged again in the future. Presently, permitting and workloads are the biggest challenges in expediting this effort.



The MSBU is eveluating dredging both this channel and is conducting an interior bathymetric survey for spot dredging portions of the canal system inside the lock. We hope to perform this work simultaneously. We will keep you appraised on the progress, but in the interim, please refer to the attaced map and be aware of the present shortcomings. Please attend the next MSBU meeting in December if further information is required.

We are also pleased to inform you that we have installed a Marine Radio for communication with the lock tender. Communications with the Lock Tender during operating hours is on channel 72.
