

"There is so much that goes into pulling off this event from start to finish, months and months of planning and details. There are so many behind the scenes people that we cannot give enough thanks and praise too." Community Emergency Response Team South Gulf Cove Charlotte County, FL. Neighbor Helping Neighbor

Neighbors Helping Neighbors Stay Safe

Operating under the umbrella of CCT, the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT Team) is a dedicated group of highly motivated residents from SGC who have volunteered to take the required training for the purpose of forming and developing our local group. The heart of the CERT program is "A Neighbor Helping Neighbor."

How are we funded?

CERT is self-funded. There are no tax dollars provided by the County. The County only provides training for volunteers. Funding is needed to maintain the trailer, stock all the necessary supplies and provide go bags for our volunteers.

What does this mean for you?

In case of a major disastrous event, County provided emergency services could be negatively impacted and communication may be impinged. As soon as possible and when safe to do so, CERT assessment patrols start a visual survey of our community to determine damage levels and provide aid to those who require it. If our community experiences a significant destructive incident, the CERT team would provide a first response benefit to all SGC residents.

SGC CERT is looking for "Friends of SGC CERT". Someone may be interested in joining but the county training has been postponed for some reason. Residents may have had prior training in emergency response or have additional equipment for use during an emergency. Our SGC CERT team and community will always welcome your help.

The CERT team has been hard at work raising funds to implement a communication system in the event SGC is ever faced with another disaster like Hurricane Ian.

Progress update since October

- Save the date: Parrot jack Head Party is scheduled for April 6th...tickets on sale now
- CERT Bingo fundraiser TBD
- Purchased radio support items: lithium iron phosphate 50 amp hour battery, stand alone battery to power a laptop, solar panels to recharge batteries, laptop computer for WINLINK email communication(especially during power outages) via HAM radio hookup, coax cables, and various antenna connectors
- CERT coordinated with CCFLARES on a few of their HAM radio and WINLINK drills
- CERT conducted a "post-disaster" drill in SGC. The drill was very successful. They had 7 teams do a search pattern in SGC at various locations looking for specific items and utilized the radio system to communicate what they found.





The Neighborhood Watch Program does not eliminate the need for home security systems.

The Neighborhood Watch Program is made up of Primary, Substitute, and Roaming Volunteers. The volunteers are the BACKBONE of the program. Without the volunteers there would NOT be a Neighborhood Watch Program. Each volunteer is issued a magnetic sign to put on their car door and the Charlotte County Sheriff's office provides vests which identify them as a Neighborhood Watch Volunteer.

Monthly meetings are held at the SGC Clubhouse on the second Thursday of each month with the Charlotte County Sheriff's Office and anyone interested in the program is welcome to attend.



SGCYC has Special Committees that include:


- Membership Processes all new membership applications, puts together welcome packages and performs check ins for monthly membership meetings.

The Purpose of the Waterways MSBU is to provide for: (1) periodic dredging, (2) any repair, expansion or replacement of the waterways, canals, locks or accessory facilities, (3) operation of the lock, and (4) the removal of cattails from the Interceptor Lagoon waterway. Currently each wet lot in SGC, Holiday Lakes, and Harbor West pay \$50 annually to the MSBU, and dry lots pay \$25.

Meetings are open to the Public and the advisory board encourages anyone in the community to attend the quarterly meetings. The next meetings will be held at the Ann & Chuck Dever Recreational Center-6961 San Casa Drive Englewood--May 22, 2024, September 25, 2024 and December 18, 2024. Below are the minutes from the February 7, 2024 Meeting:

Unfinished Business:

Parallel Lock/Tender House: No current updates. Ms. McDonald summarized a meeting to discuss issues with the contractor and the possibility of addressing failing conduit for the existing lock in coordination with the design of the tender house. The Advisory Board expressed their concern for the lack of progress on the design.

Interior Bathymetric Survey: The bathymetric survey was reviewed and conversation followed regarding moving forward with an interior dredge project, conducting additional surveys and dredging of the exterior channel from the lock to the harbor. Ms. McDonald confirmed this bathymetric survey was \$49,730. The Advisory Board agreed to seek community input and review potential additional areas to survey for discussion at the next meeting.

Existing Lock Maintenance/Cameras: Ms. McDonald confirmed the additional cylinders had arrived early and staff anticipates the lock being down to replace another one will be scheduled soon. Discussion ensued regarding the recent outages due to the corrosion of the cables and a Florida Power & Light (FPL) outage. The Advisory Board would like to move forward with the tender house, even if the parallel lock cannot. The Board of County Commissioners approved staff to move forward with acquiring easements for utilities for the tender house and cameras. Ms. McDonald noted permanent lock tenders will be budgeted and hired in the future. Staff is looking into scheduling options and how that will affect the budget. The Advisory Board discussed the benefits to having lock tenders and requested to know the financial impact of the transition from temporary to permanent employees.

South Gulf Cove Streets & Drainage MSBU update 1/18/2024

The purpose of the Streets and Drainage MSBU is to provide for the construction, reconstruction, repair, paving, hard-surfacing, re-hard surfacing, widening, guttering and draining of the platted streets in the unit, including the necessary appurtenances thereto, including beautification and landscaping projects, from funds derived from special assessments within the unit only. The following information is provided from the MSBU Advisory Committee meeting held on Jan 18, 2024:

The following bridges: (1.)Appleton Blvd, at Santa Cruz WW, (2.) Keystone Blvd. at Santa Cruz WW, (3.) Keystone Blvd, at President WW, (4.) Ingraham Blvd. at President WW, will be the first four bridges in SGC to be Rehabilitated. They are the only bridges without sidewalks which will be added during the Rehabilitation process. Bids to the county are due by Jan 24, 2024. Construction is expected to start in mid March, 2024. One bridge at a time will be rehabbed within a 90 day time frame. The subject bridge will be closed during the rehab process. **The public is encouraged to attend the meetings. Meeting dates are: 4/11/24, 7/18/24, 10/10/24**

Corporate Revitalization, A New Board of Directors, FPL Power Extensions, and Blue Stream Internet have all enabled this area to really take off.

The Waterview Property Owners Association (Section 94) includes all 933 lots east of St Paul Street toward the Interceptor Lagoon. The Waterview Property Owners Associations main function is to conserve the Native Florida Greenbelt Property that is owned by Waterview Property Owners Association, and maintain Waterview Owners' Home Values and the quality of our community. Waterview's Environmental Control Committee (ECC) is here to assist Waterview homeowners in developing their property within the Waterview Covenants and Restrictions, and the Waterview ECC (ARCH) guidelines which can all be found on our website WaterviewPOA.com. In 2023, Waterview ECC (ARCH) approved 21 ARCH applications. Our Waterview ECC (ARCH) Guidelines are very similar to SGC ARCH Guidelines with four exceptions listed below:

1. New Home living Areas must be at least 2000 air-conditioned sqft.

2. New Homes must have a minimum of a two-car enclosed attached garage with a minimum 468 sqft.

3. New Homes must have an entry door plane with a minimum of 6 ft 4. No metal structures are permitted




