
2ND ANNUAL FREAKY TIKI FUNDRAISER





South Gulf Cove Community Response Team (SGCCERT)

Community Emergency Response Team (CERT Team) is a dedicated group of highly motivated residents from SGC who have volunteered to take the required training for the purpose of forming and developing our local group. The heart of the CERT program is "A Neighbor Helping Neighbor' SGC CERT is self-funded. There are no tax dollars provided by the County. The County only provides training for volunteers. Funding is needed to maintain the trailer, stock all the necessary supplies and provide go bags for our volunteers. SGC CERT is looking for "Friends of SGC CERT". Someone may be interested in joining but the county training has been postponed for some reason. Residents may have had prior training in emergency response or have additional equipment for use during an emergency. Our SGC CERT team and community will always welcome your help.


Harbor Village Proposed Amendment----You as homeowners need to be aware of the newly proposed changes being driven by Maronda Homes for the development known as Harbor Village. The original development known as West County Town Center was approved in 2009. Maronda is seeking to expand the geographical footprint of the project to now include water front access along the entire Butterford Waterway. The amendment would allow for re-zoning of land which has previously been deemed as essential land by FDEP Florida Forever plan and was part of the Charlotte Harbor Estuary Plan started in 1972. They are trying to re-zone the Coastal High Hazard area. Maronda is also pushing to reclassify A Perpetual Conservations easement and replace it with a Wetland and Natural Resource Plan so that what was once a preserve will now be part of passive recreational activities, a term that has not yet been defined by Maronda. 
What does that mean to us -



- 2. What was once considered protected or essential lands will now, for the most part, become available for passive recreational activities.
- 3. Wildlife like manatees which often enter our waterways would be at risk.
- 4. Mangroves which run the entire length of the canal could be removed
- 5. Our neighborhoods would be prone to additional risk of flooding not only due to coastal flooding but fluvial flooding

The risk to us as Homeowners will increase significantly from rain runoff, flooding and we will lose what remains of the natural habitat along the Charlotte Harbor Estuary.

We urge you to attend the Town Hall scheduled for early May along with signing the petition and attending the Board of County Commissioners meeting on May 27 to be heard by our commissioners and put a stop to this absurd and ridiculous request to re-zone this project. Thank you John Osanitsch for writing this article for the SGC Community.

- The HOA would receive \$14,000 a year plus a 2% raise after that.








SGC Neighborhood Watch Program

"Slow Speed, Minimum Wake Zone"

Areas where vessels must be fully off plane and completely settled in the water. Any wake created by a vessel in one of these zones must be minimal (very small) If your vessel is traveling with the bow even slightly elevated while in one of these zones, it is not proceeding at "Slow Speed" as required by law.

Statement from Charlotte County Public Works on opening the Lock on March 26th

Public Works is aware that water levels have been dropping in the South Gulf Cove waterway system, and want to assure the community that staff is actively monitoring the situation.

According to the permit for the lock, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) allows the County to open the lock separating the Connector/Butterford Waterway and South Gulf Cove waterway system to raise the water levels on an annual basis when water levels drop below normal. Normal = 20 inches below the cap of the seawall at 9255 Key West St. The annual lock opening shall take place only during high tide, over a five-day period, within daytime hours, while a manatee spotter is present.

As per regulations, water can be allowed back into the canals once the levels drop to a certain point. As of April 9th, we have not reached that threshold.

Learn to live with the Alligators and educate yourself to these helpful hints

Yes, alligator mating season in Florida typically begins in April, with courtship starting in early April and mating occurring in May or June.

Here's a more detailed breakdown:

- Courtship: Alligator courtship, which involves behaviors like males lifting their tails and slapping the water, begins in early April.
- Mating: The actual mating season occurs in May and June.
- Nesting and Egg Laying: Female alligators build nests of soil, vegetation, or debris and lay 32 to 46 eggs in late June or early July.
- Hatching: Eggs hatch in late August or early September.
- Safety Tips: During mating season, it's important to be aware of alligators and take precautions, such as keeping pets on leashes, not feeding alligators, and swimming only in designated areas
- Alligator Population: There are an estimated 1.3 million alligators in Florida.
