

Response from a Letter to the Editor: Lighting issues in South Gulf Cove Let's Protect Our Night Skies and Wildlife

South Gulf Cove is a special place—blessed with natural beauty, a vibrant bird sanctuary, and breathtaking night skies filled with stars. It's one of the reasons so many of us chose to live here. But lately, our community has been experiencing more and more unnecessary light pollution.

Excessive outdoor lighting doesn't just diminish our view of the stars; it disrupts the delicate balance of wildlife, from birds to other creatures that thrive in natural darkness. It can also become a nuisance to neighbors, turning what should be peaceful nights into sleepless frustrations.

The solution is simple: be mindful. If you install motion lights, consider how they shine —fixtures should point downward, not outward, to avoid blinding your neighbors. And when you turn in for the night, ask yourself: is it too much to simply switch off the lights?

We didn't move to a city—we live in a rural, waterfront sanctuary. Let's keep it that way. By being considerate with our lighting, we can protect our wildlife, preserve our star-filled skies, and keep South Gulf Cove the peaceful, beautiful place we all love.






Tired of paying property tax on vacant land?

South Gulf Cove Community Emergency Response Team (SGCCERT)

Operating under the umbrella of CCT, the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT Team) is a dedicated group of highly motivated residents from SGC who have volunteered to take the required training for the purpose of forming and developing our local group. The heart of the CERT program is "A Neighbor Helping Neighbor"

SGC CERT is self-funded. There are no tax dollars provided by the County. The County only provides training for volunteers. Funding is needed to maintain the trailer, stock all the necessary supplies and provide go bags for our volunteers.

SGC CERT is looking for "Friends of SGC CERT". Someone may be interested in joining but the county training has been postponed for some reason. Residents may have had prior training in emergency response or have additional equipment for use during an emergency. Our SGC CERT team and community will always welcome your help.

In case of an Emergency..... Internet down? Cell Towers down? WinLink to the rescue!

If cell towers and WiFi go down after a disaster, like they were after Hurricane Ian, SGC CERT can help get short messages out to your loved ones using HAM radio and WINLINK. We relay messages to a contact outside the affected area who can update the rest of your friends and family.

To use this service, designate one out-of-area contact in advance. After an event, you'll fill out a brief form (required by the FCC & Emergency management) with your 25-word message. We'll prioritize emergency needs first. Questions? Email us at cert@southgulfcovecct.org.


Huge thanks to Administrator **Melody Bare**







SGC Neighborhood Watch Program



Getting Social with the SGC Yacht Club

South Gulf Cove Yacht Club established via the Florida Article of Incorporation under chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes as a non-profit social club(501C7) in June 1998. The club was founded by 5 SGC families and has grown to over 500 families. We welcome new members via membership application. New membership applications can be found online on the South Gulf Cove Yacht club website sqcyc.com There is a one-time initiation fee of \$50, and an annual fee of \$50. The SGCYC hosts monthly meetings on the first Tuesday of each month (except for the month of July) at the American Legion post 113. 3436 Indiana Road, Rotonda West FL 33947. Meetings begin at 7:30 pm and usually last about an hour. We also encourage members to stay after the meetings for a social hour.

Areas where vessels must be fully off plane and completely settled in the water. Any wake created by a vessel in one of these zones must be minimal (very small) If your vessel is traveling with the bow even slightly elevated while in one of these zones, it is not proceeding at "Slow Speed" as required by law.


South Gulf Cove Boat Ramp Update

Friends of South Gulf Cove (FoSGC) Community update: Harbor Village Development and Harbor East



The recent decision regarding the Harbor Village Planned Development (PD) marks a pivotal moment for the residents of South Gulf Cove and surrounding waterfront communities. What began as a concerning proposal—with docks lining the Interceptor and Butterford Waterways—became a galvanizing call to action for hundreds of engaged neighbors who care deeply about our water quality, wildlife habitat, and community character.

Thanks to the tireless efforts of local residents, community advocates, and grassroots organizers like the Friends of South Gulf Cove (FoSGC), the final outcome of the PD includes several critical protections that would not have happened without community involvement:

- No docks will be permitted along the Interceptor or Butterford Waterways. All docking infrastructure must remain within the internal marina. This is now written into the PD.
- A designated "protected greenbelt" will preserve all existing mangroves along the Interceptor, with trimming restricted to what is allowed under FDEP regulations.
- The greenbelt will not be deeded to private homeowners, helping ensure it remains preserved for the greater public benefit.
- The commercial portion of the project will maintain a minimum of 950,000 square feet, helping protect the area's planned mixed-use character.

This victory belongs to the residents who sent emails, signed petitions, spoke at meetings, and shared accurate information across social media platforms. It proves that when we band together as neighbors—with a shared vision and respect for the unique beauty of our area—we can help shape decisions that affect us all. We extend our sincere thanks to every neighbor who spoke up or showed up, to Maronda Homes for listening and working with FoSGC and the community, to the County staff for revising the language, and to the Commissioners for approving a revision that ultimately serves both the residents and the county.

"Let this be a reminder that our voices matter—and that we are the true stewards of South Gulf Cove."

We want to thank our neighbors for staying engaged and supporting efforts to protect the integrity of South Gulf Cove and its surrounding waterways.

FoSGC recently met with State and County agencies to address several concerns that came to light during the Harbor Village development hearings. These concerns include enforcement of State and County codes, encroachments near the State Preserve/Greenbelt, and dock violations within protected waterways.

Here's what's happening: Charlotte County planning & Zoning:

The County is currently investigating code violations and dock placement issues related to the Harbor East (HE) portion of the Lennar development.

- The eastern and western sections of Harbor East borders land with limited Right of Way(ROW) access and crossings.
- A County Staff meeting with Lennar is scheduled to review these issues. FoSGC will receive updates and share them with the community.

Southwest Florida Water Management District:

- SWFWMD is reviewing concerns with both Harbor East and Harbor West developments.
- The "as-built" documents for Harbor East are missing key components.
- The western portion of HE falls under strict Water Management "land use" rules outlined in the original Planned Development approval.

Looking Ahead:

FoSGC remains committed to education, transparency, and partnership. Many of these issues could have been avoided if County Codes, HOA and ARC guidelines had been clearly communicated to homeowners, builders, and dock companies from the start. For example, Harbor East's own HOA and ARC documents outline proper dock placement and land use. To support residents and reduce confusion moving

Boca Community Access Alliance Beach Parking Update

This past month, our community has rallied to raise awareness about the impact of the new Lee County Parking Ordinance, which effectively restricts public parking on Boca Grande. Streets 1–19 are now off-limits unless you have a residential, business, or visitor pass. Off-island residents are excluded. Limited 3-hour parking downtown remains, and churches were granted Sunday median parking.

The consequences have been swift and damaging. Businesses on Gasparilla Island report up to a 30% drop in customers, and the GIBA reports a 25% decrease in traffic. This is not just a local issue—this affects us all. Gasparilla Island is part of our shared community.

We were present at the August 5th Lee County meeting where the ordinance was passed, and we continue to fight. On September 9th, the Charlotte County Commissioners took action:

- They're sending a resolution to Lee County asking for parking to be restored, with a 30-day response window.
- They've asked the county attorney to review Senate Bill 180 as a possible legal route if Lee County refuses to cooperate.

Residents have proposed alternatives, and Charlotte County is researching their own. They understand the ripple effects this ordinance could have—including overcrowding at Englewood Beach.

This is about fairness, transparency, and protecting shared access. Lee County taxpayers should be aware: over \$35 million in state funds have gone to Boca beach renourishment, with more to come through 2056.

We've filed multiple public records requests and are tracking legal follow-ups promised by Senator Albritton and Representatives Nix and Oliver.

This fight isn't over. The only way we win is together—united as a community, standing shoulder to shoulder.

SGC Waterway MSBU

Do you have questions regarding the SGC canals, lock, maintenance, dredging and cattail removing? Attend the Waterway MSBU meeting to get them answered!

The purpose of this unit is to provide for (1) periodic dredging, (2) any repair, expansion or replacement of the waterways, canals, locks or accessory facilities, (3) operation of the lock, and (4) the removal of cattails from the Interceptor Lagoon waterway.

MSBU Lock Update

The South Gulf Cove MSBU has spent the past three years gathering real-time data on the community lock. Results show the lock is operating efficiently and is far from over capacity. With tenders on duty, a single boat passes through in about four minutes, and multiple boats only add about a minute each. This means the lock could handle 34 boats per hour, or 411 boats per day.

In reality, the busiest day in the last three years saw only 232 boats (56% of capacity), and just four days total exceeded 200 boats. Nearly one-third of days logged fewer than 25 boats, while 62% of the time the lock was used at less than 12% of its capacity. Average use has been 39 boats per weekday and 68 on weekends. Since the County hired lock tenders, maintenance issues have decreased, uptime has climbed above 90%, and wait times are usually under 10 minutes. This is a dramatic improvement compared to years past, when downtime was more common.

MSBU Lock Update continued

Despite this, Charlotte County has already spent over \$500,000 pursuing permits for a parallel lock—part of a proposed \$12.9 million project. After seven years, federal approvals remain stalled, with the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service yet to approve. Even in a best-case scenario, the Army Corps of Engineers would take at least two more years to review.

The white paper concludes that, based on actual usage, environmental challenges, and cost, the County Commissioners should reconsider the necessity of a parallel lock. Instead, focus may be better placed on maintaining and extending the life of the current lock to ensure continued reliability for the community.
